WORSHIP PREVIEW

This week, our worship experience will blend two important truths: God's Love and Christ's Light. Whether you enjoy or avoid Valentine's Day, we all have one inescapable need: to feel loved. Love is a core value of Cold Spring Church's mission. God loves us more than we can possibly imagine. "For God loved the world that he gave his one and only Son..." (John 3:16-17). We seek to, "love one another with mutual affection..." and to "outdo one another in showing honor" (Romans 12:10).

Just then a light-radiant cloud enveloped them, and from deep in the cloud, a voice: "This is my Son, marked by my love. Listen to him." The next minute the disciples were looking around, rubbing their eyes, seeing nothing but Jesus, only Jesus. Coming down the mountain, Jesus swore them to secrecy. "Don't tell a

soul what you saw. After the Son of Man rises from the dead, you're
