Key Words: Sacrifice

Key Verse: "The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep." John 10:3

When Jesus was growing up, there were shepherds all around where he lived. Those shepherds walked ahead of their sheep, leading them. This is quite different from the shepherds we think of who follow the sheep.

Jesus tells us he is the "Good Shepherd." He means that he is the leader, and we are supposed to follow him. He knows that it is our choice to decide whether we follow closely, or far behind, but we know he is always there to guide us.

He tells us, too, that he cares for us, and that if we should "get lost" he will do all that he can to rescue us, if we choose to be rescued. There will always be some people who choose not to follow, who choose to "go astray" not wishing to be found, and Jesus lets them make that choice, even when it makes him sad.

Jesus also tells us that he is the "gate" of the sheepfold. When he was growing up, there were no fences or gates around the sheep. The shepherd acted like a gate keeping away the thieves and robbers, and any wild beasts hoping to attack the sheep.

Jesus is our gate. He is our protector. If we believe in him, and love him with all of our hearts, our souls, and our being, he will protect us. He will help us deal with harmful attackers. He will protect our hearts and souls.

Jesus, I love you Here I wait Protected daily By you, as my gate. Jesus, my shepherd I choose to follow you Asking your lead In all that I do. Amen.

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
