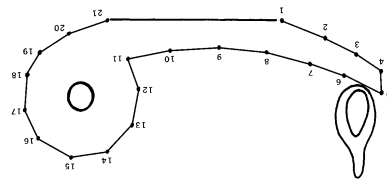
Jesus told Nicodemus that the darkness is where people hide when they are ashamed. If they are doing things they should not do, they try to hide them.

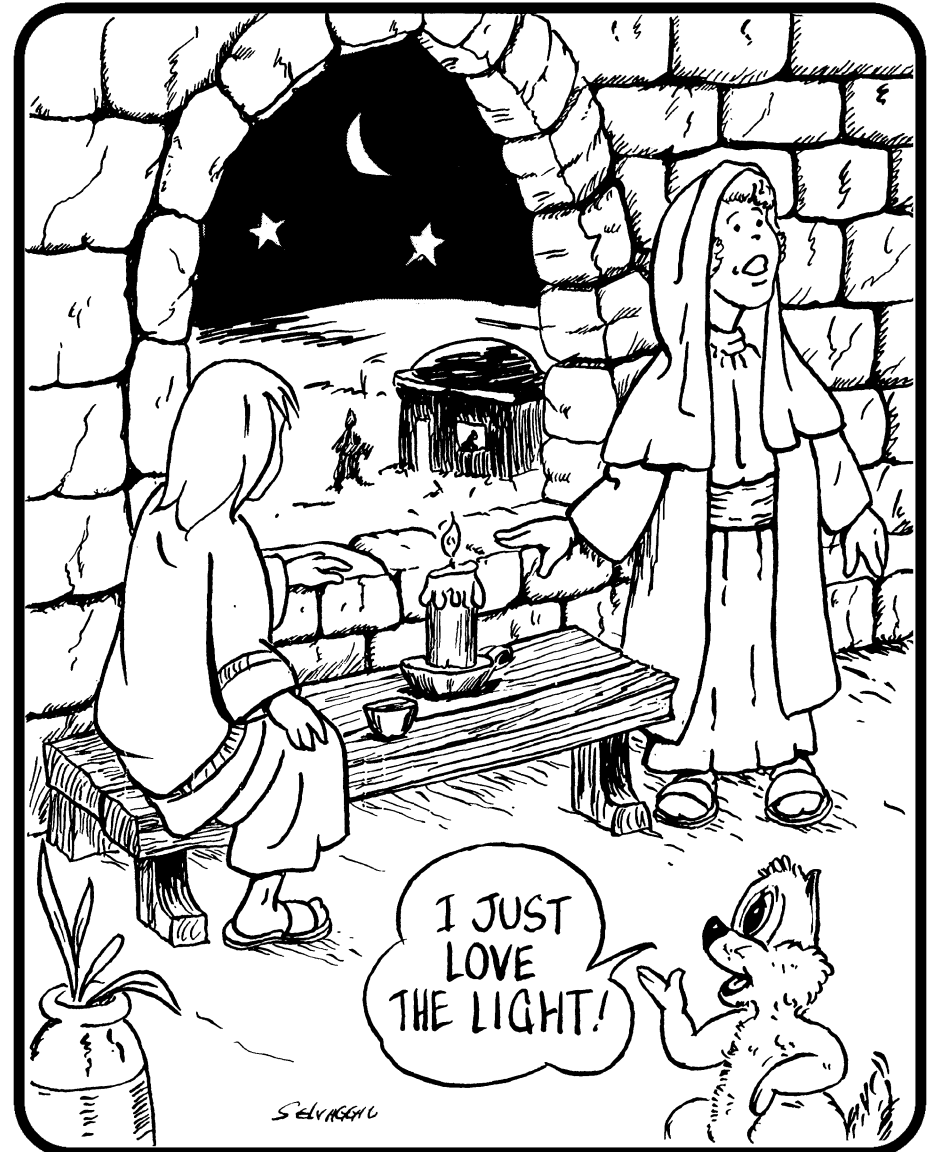

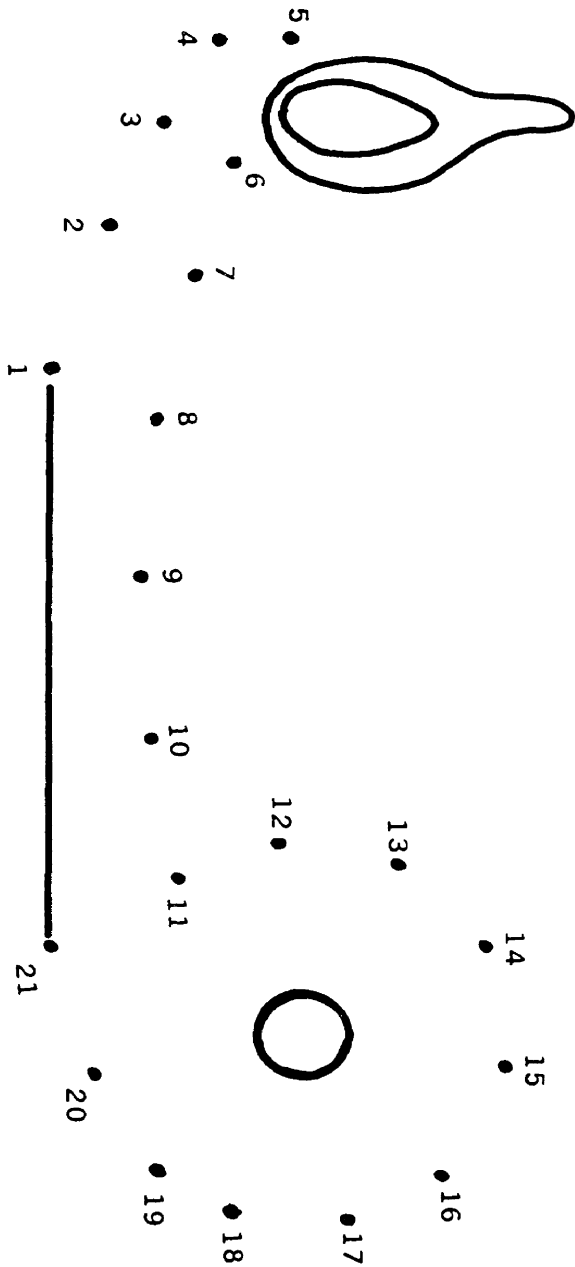
