They wondered if Jesus was just a ghost now, instead of a real person. But when Jesus came to them, he ate some fish right in front of them. They realized Jesus was more than just a ghost.

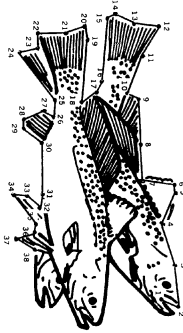

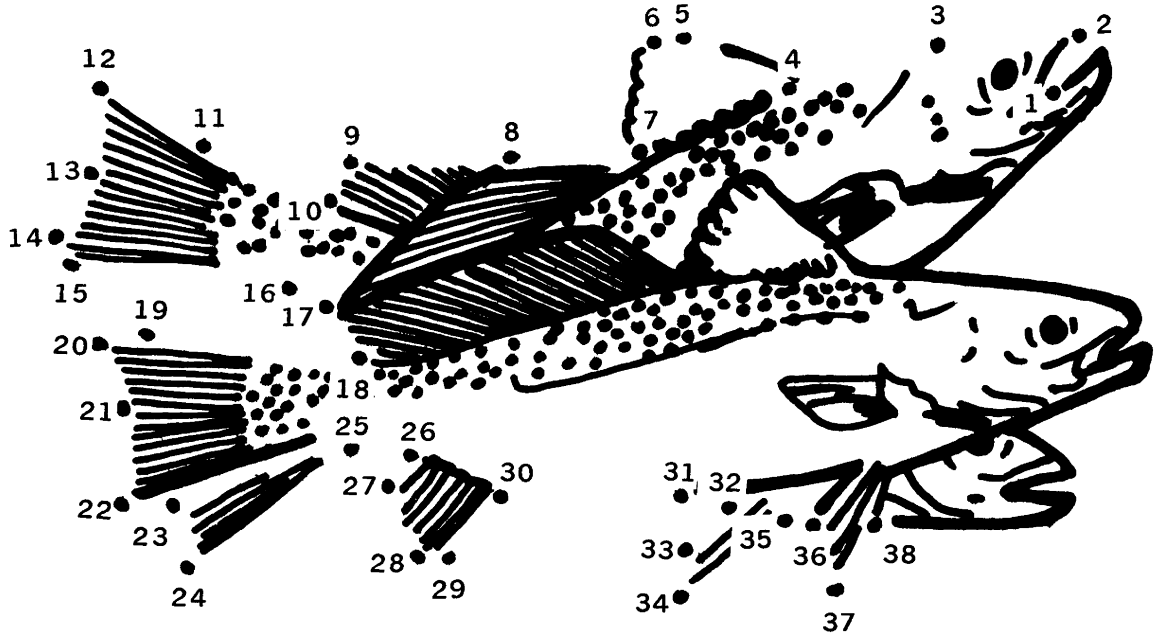
