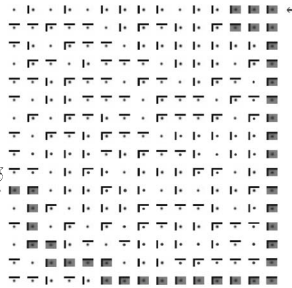
Why didn't the disciples know that it was Jesus standing on the shore?
