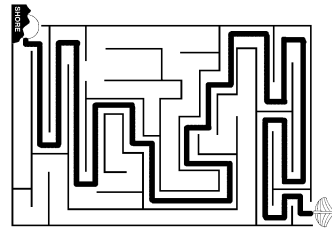
Everything became still.

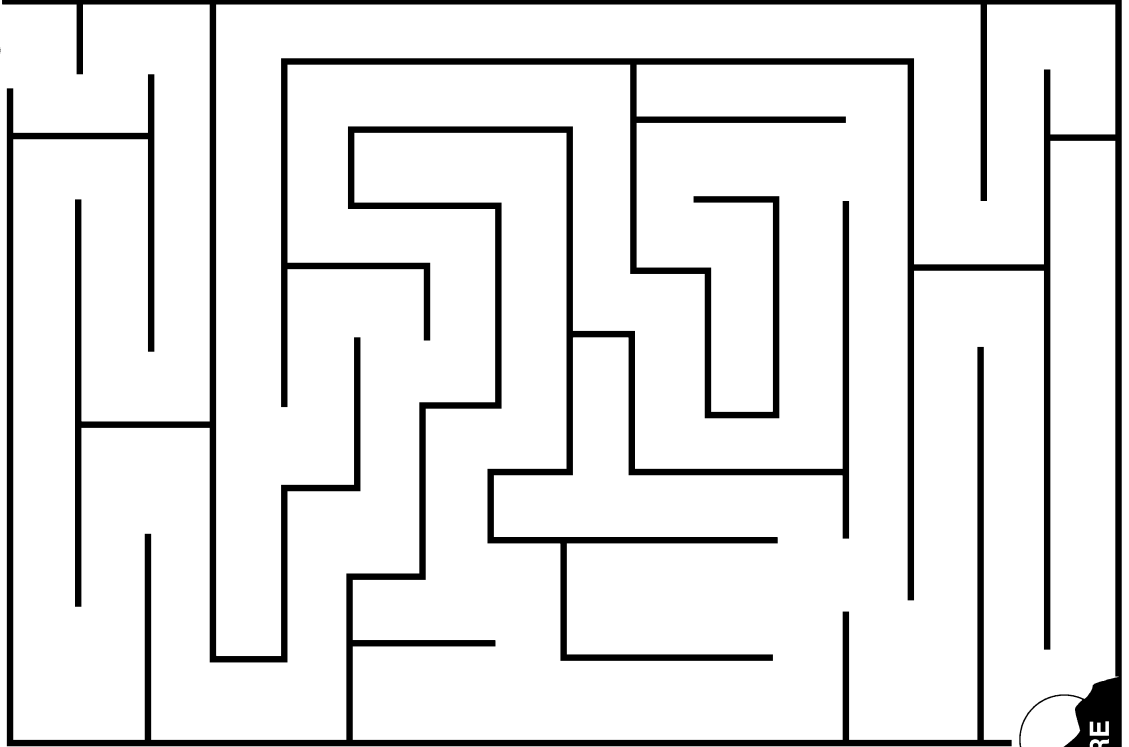
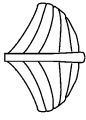
