Thank you for joining us today! Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent with a public act of confession and contrition. Acknowledging that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God, we stand in solidarity as fellow creatures before our Creator, acutely aware of our mortality. We also celebrate God's grace and love, and pledge ourselves anew to the journey to live better-

aligned to God's emerging future in Christ. Plan to gain needed spiritual resources as we gather for worship each Sunday in Lent.

WORSHIP PREVIEW

Our neighbors are feeling more and more like strangers to one another and more isolated since the pandemic began. People report loneliness as a persistent experience more than 70% of the time. How can we turn strangers into friends? How can our places of mission and worship become more welcoming? Let's realize that others are as awkward as we may be! During the next 40 days be open to new ways to turn strangers into fellow travelers, companions, friends, to embrace God's emerging future that leads to the cross and the empty tomb. Here's how scripture puts Lenten advice: "Don't be a mean-faced people, cruel to grandmothers and babies alike" (Deut. 28:50). 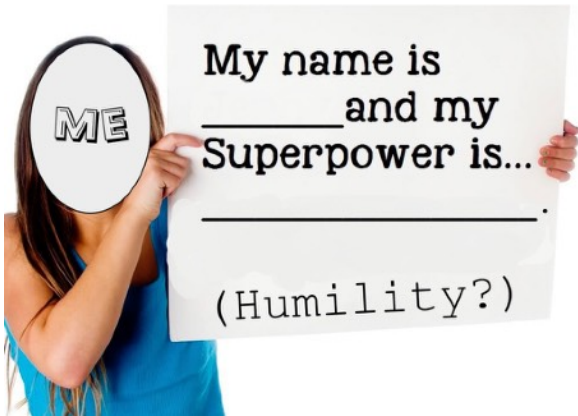
May we put feasts and games aside;

GOSPEL READING: MATTHEW 6:16-21 (NIV)

"And whenever you fast, do not put on a dismal face like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces so as to show others that they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward. But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that your fasting may be seen not by others but by your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you. "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust consume and where thieves break in and steal; but store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust consumes and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also"

INVITATION TO OBSERVE A LENTEN DISCIPLINE

Let us begin our Lenten journey by confessing our sins and seeking the forgiveness and new life that is promised to us in Christ Jesus.

COMMUNITY CONFESSION (PSALM 51) (MSG)

Left: Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

Right: For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Against you, you alone, have I sinned, and done what is evil in your sight, so that you are justified in your sentence when you pass judgment.

Left: I was born guilty, a sinner when I was born. You desire truth in the inward being; therefore teach me wisdom in my secret heart. Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

Right: Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have crushed rejoice. Hide your face from my sins, and blot out my iniquities.

Left: Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me. Do not cast me away from your presence, and do not take your holy spirit from me.

Right: Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and sustain in me a willing spirit.

Left: Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and they will return to you.

Right: Deliver me from bloodshed, O God, O God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of your deliverance.

Left: O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise. For you do not delight in

sacrifice and you are not pleased with a burnt offering.

All: The sacrifice acceptable to God is an open spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Almighty God, you have created us out of the dust of the earth. May these ashes be a sign of our mortality and penitence and a reminder that only your gracious gift can help us put on the face of grace; through Jesus Christ, the Savior.
