WORSHIP PREVIEW

Following the message we will sing The Lord's My Shepherd, I'll Not Want. This paraphrase of Psalm 23 comes from the so-called Scottish Psalter of 1650, actually produced by the Westminster Assembly and intended for use by all Presbyterian's in the British Isles in place of the Sternhold & Hopkins “Old Version” of the Church of England.

Our sending hymn is Now Thank We All Our God. Although this hymn is often used on large and festive occasions, it's first two stanzas had much humbler beginnings: they originated as a family table prayer during the Thirty Years War (1618-1648). These words have been associated with this tune since the mid 17th century.

GOSPEL READING: LUKE 11:1-13 NIV

One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, “Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples.”

He said to them, “When you pray, say: “ ‘Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. And lead us not into temptation.’ ”

Then Jesus said to them, “Suppose you have a friend, and you go to him at midnight and say, ‘Friend, lend me three loaves of bread; a friend of mine on a journey has come to me, and I have no food to offer him.’ And suppose the one inside answers, ‘Don’t bother me. The door is already locked, and my children and I are in bed. I can’t get up and give you anything.’ I tell you, even though he will not get up and give you the bread because of friendship, yet because of

your shameless audacity he will surely get up and give you as much as you need. “

So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

“Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!”

SILENT REFLECTION

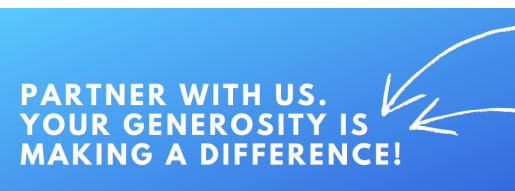
HEAR THE WORDS OF ASSURANCE (RESPONSIVE)
