WORSHIP PREVIEW

The message this week from Norris Clark is "**Profiles in Courage: Part 2 -**Facing Fears for Love".

MUSIC PREVIEW

Following the message we will sing *"All Who Love and Serve Your City"* by Erik Routley. This hymn follows in a line of important hymns about ministry in the urban context following the Industrial Revolution. Two familiar predecessors of our hymn include "O Master, Let Me Walk with Thee" and "Where Cross the Crowded Ways of Life. These hymns were inspired in part by the social gospel of Walter Rauschenbusch (1861-1918). Rauschenbusch believed that the kingdom of God should be advanced not by evangelistic preaching of the revivals of this era, but by becoming more Christlike. He believed that we could experience heaven on earth by loving our neighbors and creating healthy social conditions, meeting the needs of the poor.

Our closing hymn is *"To God Be the Glory", written by Fanny Crosby.* Most gospel songs center on Christ, but this hymn directly addresses God, who has done great things. The primary focus of God's actions, however, is on the redemption of humanity through Jesus Christ. The second line of the first stanza, "So loved he the world that he gave us his Son," echoes John 3:16.
