WORSHIP PREVIEW

We welcome Rev. Dr. Nicole Wilkinson, Pastor of Cape May Presbyterian Church, this morning. We thank her for providing our congregation with Communion and allowing Norris Clark to fill in at her church while she is with us today. Her message is "Building the Community in Worship: Honesty".

WE GATHER AT THE LORD'S TABLE

Celebrate at Jesus' table this week and be spiritually nourished. Our in-person worshippers will be receiving communion. Our online worshippers may request communion by contacting the office. Or, choose the bread you prefer. You may use grape juice or wine or water for the cup, remembering that Christ is the Living Water.

MUSIC PREVIEW

Following the message we will sing "Take My Life and Let It Be", written by Frances R. Havergal. In her own words, the hymn is a "consecration hymn" in which the singer commits all of her possessions and being to the Lord for his purposes.

The Communion hymn is "Let Us Break Bread Together", an African American spiritual. American slaves could communicate the intention of escaping by singing "Let us break bread together" It is a hymn of the Underground Railroad. The hymn is common in holy communion services, reminding us of our spiritual food and drink presented through the bread and wine.

Our closing hymn is "Song of Hope". The hymn alludes to Romans 15:13, which states, "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." This gives us the opening phrase and sets up the idea of hope—a hope that supports and encourages Christians to strive for justice.
