#### **WORSHIP PREVIEW**

Pastor David Wenker's message is "Living as The Beloved: Chosen". Feelings of rejection are so uncomfortable we will do all sorts of things to avoid them. We have all experienced rejection, whether it is in our relationships, our work, or it can even happen in church. Our message today is that our God does not reject us. He intentionally, out of a motivation of love, chooses us. He picks us to be on his team. This Sunday we will look at some ways we can intentionally live into being God's chosen beloved child.

#### MUSIC PREVIEW

The opening hymn Guide Me, O Thou Great Jehovah, has been used for worship in congregations around the globe and across denominational lines. The author of this widely popular hymn William Williams, beautifully interweaves imagery from the Old Testament book of Exodus to evoke a sense of God's guidance through strife. One of the reasons this hymn has influenced such a broad array of congregants is the universal subject of struggle. Every Christian, and indeed everyone, encounters difficulties. "Guide Me, O Thou Great Jehovah" affirms the reality that God provides for us and redeems all wrong in the world.

The hymn after the message is Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing. Robert Robinson was a rather difficult, headstrong boy, and when his Dad died, things only got worse. So, when he turned 14 in 1749, his mother sent him to London for an apprenticeship. He was just as much a troublemaker in London, and to make matters worse he gained some friends and followers as a leader!

When he was 17, he took his gang to a revival service where a well-known preacher, George Whitfield, was speaking. After hearing the message, it moved him deeply and it made him rethink his life and how he was living

it. Nearly three years after hearing that sermon, a twenty-year-old Robert Robinson made his peace with God, and "found full and free forgiveness through the precious blood of Jesus Christ." Joining the Methodists, and feeling the call to preach, the self-taught Robinson was appointed by John Wesley himself to the Calvinist Methodist Chapel in Norfolk, England. It was there, to accompany his sermon for Pentecost Sunday in 1858, the three-year anniversary of his conversion, he penned the words of this hymn: "Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing."

The closing hymn My Tribute, is a gospel song written by American gospel singer and songwriter Andraé Crouch. He first recorded it in 1972 on his album Keep on Singin'. It is considered one of Crouch's most well-known songs.
