WORSHIP PREVIEW

Pastor David Wenker's message is : "My God Shall Supply"

When we feel separated from God, and facing challenges in life, we have a sense sometimes we are not enough and will not have enough. We will be looking at the

promise in Philippians 4:19 where God promises all our needs will be supplied through Christ Jesus. It is important to consider that not all our wants will be satisfied. Sorting out what are our wants and what are our needs is what we will be considering in the sermon. This passage seems especially appropriate on Mother's Day when mother's often feel overwhelmed by the responsibilities and challenges that never end, no matter how old the children.
