WORSHIP PREVIEW

Pastor Dave's message today is "Our Patient and Persistent God". When asked about our day we often say, "Same old, same old, different day". Jeremiah offers a different way of approaching each new day. In the midst of the everyday challenges and troubles of life, God offers fresh grace and mercy. God is faithful and patient and persistent in pursuing our hearts. We can choose an optimistic attitude when we are open to receive God's fresh gifts of grace each new day.

MUSIC PREVIEW

The gathering hymn, "Great is Thy Faithfulness", was written as a meditation on Lamentations 3:22-23, this text is one of the few hymns among the 1200 poems by this Methodist writer and pastor that has gained much currency. The tune that appears here was composed especially for these words, and the pairing has proved enduring.

"His Eye is On the Sparrow" is the hymn of meditation following the message. This hymn based on Jesus' saying about God's care for all creatures (Matthew 10:29-30/Luke 12:6-7) began with the refrain's last line, inspired by a woman who had endured much illness. It was first sung in public at the Royal Albert Hall, London, during evangelistic services in 1905.

The closing hymn is "It Is Well With My Soul". This text is a remarkable expression of faith born of grief. The author, an active Presbyterian layman who had just lost four daughters in a tragic shipwreck, wrote it while sailing to Paris to meet his wife, who had survived. The tune, Ville de Havre, was named for the ship that sank.

The word came to Jeremiah concerning all the people of Judah in the fourth year of Jehoiakim son of Josiah king of Judah, which was the first year of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon.
